Since 2015, Freiburg experienced an enormous influx of refugees from different countries. There is a huge number of refugees between the ages of 16-30 who are attending schools and vocational training. This seminar seeks to focus on the social aspects of those people and education as a tool to ensure integration. Which social aspects seem to be problematic in the German society? In which way can education be regarded as a bridge to integrate young refugees? These are some of the questions that will be given attention to in this substantial seminar. Through explorative / research-based learning in groups, students develop the thematic field step by step. Beginning with formulation of problem definitions, uncertainties and questions, students will research about basic information, environment and structures and finally go for practical outreach-based research. In the end all groups will provide feedback in the seminar in a form of presentation and afterwards do the reflection. Finally we relate the researched subject areas to the content of the migration and diversity lecture.
